Prep for PO2 Exam

These instructions are to be given to each PO2 prior to the exam. The following 2 items pertain to the PO2 exam, but both must be prepared ahead of time.

1. Part of the PO2 is to write a lesson plan on one of the following topics:
 - Parts of a Ship
 - 24 Hour Clock
 - Wearing and Maintenance of the Uniform
 - Navy League Cadet and Officer Ranks

You are to have this lesson plan completed prior to exam night. There will not be any time given to cadets to complete their lesson plan on the night of the exam.

The Lesson Plan will be worth 20% of your final mark.

Make sure that all parts of the lesson plan are included. Don't forget to include a list of all training aids required for the lesson.

2. Part of the PO2 exam is a drill mutual. Each cadet will be tested on his/her personal drill, and should therefore be familiar with all drill movements he/she has learned up to this point. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - All standing drill (Attention, At Easy, Stand Easy, Remove and Replace Headdress, Salute, Left Turns, Right Turns, About Turns, Open and Close Order March).
 - All marching drill (Quick March, Slow March, All Turns on the March, Salute on the March, Halt, Forward).

The drill mutual is worth 25% of your final mark.

3. The PO2s will also be marked on their uniforms. Cadet uniforms are worth 20% of your final mark.
