- Items marked with an asterisk (\*) will be checked prior to leaving for camp. These are mandatory items that your child must have in order to attend camp.

- Do not bring any knives, radios/MP3 players, electronic games, money, jewelry, trading cards, or any valuables.
- There is no food allowed in the cabins. You may have unwelcome visitors (Skunks mice, etc).
- You are responsible for all of your own personal property. If you are caught with banned items, you will be disciplined, and the item(s) will be confiscated.
- Visors are not permitted as they do not protect the top of the head from the sun.
- Medications must be turned into the Medical Officer only. Please blister-pack all medications, label them, and only provide enough for the weekend.
